Dear Holidaymaker

Hello and thank you for booking with us. We hope you appreciate the quality of our caravan. Please don't hesitate to contact us if you have any problems.

**Things you need to know:-**

Butlins Minehead has a fishing pond with direct access from the caravan park, so please insure your children are safe.

**IMPORTANT - Things you need to take with you:-**

1. The "Caravan Sub-letter Entry/Registration Form To Resort". This form is required by Butlins, and you may not be allowed on to the site without it. It entitles you to up to 8 passes for the duration of your stay, and 1 parking space near to the caravan you will also be given the key to the caravan along with the passes. Any other cars must be left in the main secure car park.
2. Quilt covers, pillow cases & bottom sheets for each bed that you are going to use. The master bedroom and the fold out bed in the lounge both have a double quilt. The 4 beds in the two twin bedrooms have single quilts.

**Things that we would like you not to take with you:-**

1. No pets allowed.
2. Please avoid taking crayons felt pens, as the temptation to scribble on the walls can be irresistible for some children when they get bored.

**Where you need to go to check in:-**

As you approach butlins from the seafront road you should drive past the first entrance for approximately 200 meters. The next entrance that you come to is the access point for the caravan park. Just inside this entrance there is a small gatehouse. Stop here and hand in your "sub-letter" form. The attendant will then issue you with a Butlins pass for each person in your party and also a parking permit to park in the allocated parking space for our caravan.

The caravan is on plot 120 in River Cove, and your parking space is numbered as 120. Please see the accompanying map on the back of this letter.

We hope you have a wonderful time at Butlins and try and take time to explore outside the Butlins camp. There are some nice restaurants and pubs in Minehead town.

There is also a working steam railway which has a regular service to Taunton. Oh yes, there is also the beach!
